

Save On Your Commute. **Your Way.**

Use your commuter benefits in **Atlanta** to save money and get to work in the way that works best for you.



STEP

1

Enroll in commuter benefits with your employer.



STEP

2

Determine your pre-tax contribution amount

*This is how you save \$\$\$ on commuting to-and-from work

3

Receive your benefits debit card in the mail.



STEP

4

Spend your funds on your work commute.

Here are a few examples of how you can get to work using your commuter benefits in Atlanta:



Drive your own car and park with SpotHero.

- 1 Use the SpotHero mobile app (or go online to access the site) to find an available parking spot close to your office.
- 2 Pre-pay for your spot using your benefits debit card, drive to work, scan and show your pass, and then park in your reserved spot.



Take a LyftShared or uberPOOL.

Request your LyftShared or UberPOOL and pay for the ride using your benefits debit card.



Use your Breeze Ticket to ride the bus.

- 1 Walk to the bus station and purchase your Breeze Ticket at the vending machine, select ticket option, and pay with your benefits debit card.
- 2 Tap and pay with your Breeze Ticket to board the bus.



Ride the rail using your Breeze Card.

- 1 Place your Smart Commute order online to load funds to your Breeze card for next month.
- 2 Receive your Breeze Card in the mail.
- 3 Tap and pay with your Breeze Card to ride the rail.



Take the bus with your CobbLinc Ticket.

- 1 Purchase your CobbLinc Ticket online and use your benefits debit card to pay.
- 2 Receive your CobbLinc Ticket in the mail (typically within 7-10 days).
- 3 Board the bus and pay with your CobbLinc Ticket.



Use your Breeze Card to ride the bus.

- 1 Walk to the bus station and purchase your Breeze Card at the vending machine, select fare / pass amount, and pay with your benefits debit card.
- 2 Tap and pay with your Breeze Card to board the bus.
