Whether you're managing a handful of vehicles or a large service fleet, this checklist will help you take control of fuel expenses and prepare for cost fluctuations—**before they impact your bottom line**.

) Assess your current fuel speed

- Review monthly fuel usage by vehicle and driver
- □ Identify trends in spend over the last 6–12 months
- Benchmark fuel cost as a percentage of total operating expenses
- Calculate the financial impact of a \$0.25, \$0.50, or \$1.00/gallon increase

🚠 Set fuel budget goals

- Define cost-per-mile or cost-per-job fuel targets
- Create a best-case, base-case, and worst-case budget scenario
- Establish a maximum monthly fuel spend threshold
- Allocate buffer funds for unexpected price surges

implement cost controls

- Use fuel cards with spending limits and purchase restrictions
- Set rules around time-of-day and product-type purchases
- Enable Level III data reporting for full purchase visibility
- Regularly audit transactions for anomalies or off-policy use

% Improve efficiency with telematics

- Monitor idle time and reduce it across the fleet
- □ Analyze routing data to optimize drive time and reduce fuel waste
- Track aggressive driving behavior (e.g., speeding, hard braking)
- Schedule preventive maintenance to sustain fuel efficiency





Prevent fuel theft and fraud

- Assign unique PINs or driver IDs to fuel cards
- Enable real-time alerts for off-hours or excessive fueling
- Review exception reports weekly
- Train drivers on acceptable fueling behavior and fraud risks

Leverage vendor partnerships

- Enroll in fuel rebate programs based on volume
- Use a fuel network with widespread, in-network access
- Explore bundled service or maintenance savings with trusted partners

Revisit and adjust regularly

- Review fuel data and KPIs monthly
- Re-forecast budgets quarterly or when fuel prices spike
- Update fueling policies annually or as fleet size changes
- Communicate changes clearly with your team
